Promoting fair & impartial judging. All regulation governing this chili cook off is to keep fairness & constant to all contestants. Chili will be identified by number only.

Winners:

1st Place \$300 & trophy

2nd Place \$200 & trophy

3rd Place \$100 & trophy

All other participants will receive participating awards

1. All Chili's to be cooked offsite The Shrine will provide serving & warming trays – No frozen chili.
2. The Shrine will open the doors to the public at 2 p.m. Judging by the public will end at 5 p.m. The top 10 chili's will then be received by the finalist judge's & winner will be decided and announced at approximately 8 p.m.
3. Chili will be judged on the following
 1. Aroma
 2. Color
 3. Consistency
 4. First taste
 5. After taste

COOKING RULES

1. All chili's cooked must be from scratch with ground beef or red meat to be cubed at 1/4" to 3/8"
2. All Chili's must be red in color
3. Red beans only
4. Tomato, onions, peppers – red & green only, must be diced
5. NO OTHER FILLERS PERMITTED
6. One chili per cook or cooking team
7. All Chili's will be inspected during entry to insure they are in accordance with above regulations
8. Cook= 1 person or cook team of 2 persons
9. Any seasonings that cannot be identified by looks: Red chili powder, garlic, onion powder, salt, pepper, oregano, cumin, etc. are permitted.
10. Three gallons of chili maximum
